What to expect on "Check In Day"

Check in begins at **3:00 p.m.** on the first day of your campers' program. Please try to be on time (not too early or too late) as this will help get our program started smoothly. If you are not able to be on time for check in, please contact our office to notify us. When you enter the Lake Logan campus, please follow the signs for parking and Camp Henry check in. There will likely be a friendly counselor directing traffic and answering any questions you may have.

You will first meet the a couple of helpful Camp Henry Staff members who will check you in (making sure all paperwork and payments are complete) and give your camper their cabin assignments. At this time, your camper will be asked about any medications, allergies, illnesses, and recent or reoccurring injuries.

If needed, you will then check in with the camp healthcare provider (a licensed nurse or doctor registered in the state of North Carolina). ****If you need to discuss anything with the healthcare provider in private, we are happy to accommodate your needs. ALL medications, vitamins, and supplements must be left with the healthcare provider. We will be sure to administer medications at the time that you specify.**

Next you will receive your camp shirt and water bottle. We suggest that you label these items immediately so that if they are lost we can return them to you.

After receiving your camp shirt and water bottle, your camper will receive a lice check.

You will meet one of your counselors during the check in process. They will assist campers and families to the cabins and help campers get settled in. Parents and families are invited to help carry luggage, help campers get settled in, and tour the cabins. You know your camper best so please decide whether saying, "have a great time at camp" after check in or at the cabins is the best course of action.



What to Expect on "Check Out Day"

Check out is promptly at **10:00 a.m.** on the last day of your campers' program (Saturday). Please be on time, you may arrive a little early if you wish, but we do ask that you wait at the check out area for campers to come down from their cabins. This will enable us to clean and pack up with much more efficiency. Please follow signs and/or directions for parking. When check out begins, you will sign your camper out, receive a camp sticker, receive medications (if applicable), and check the "lost and found" table for any items that your camper may have misplaced. During this time your camper(s) will meet you and you may retrieve their luggage. We wish you a safe trip home and hope to see you the next summer.

*Please note that the Camp Store will be open at Check In and Check Out if you or your camper(s) would like to purchase any Camp Henry merchandise.



Transportation Information

Camp Henry is located at Lake Logan Conference Center in Canton, NC. For directions, you can use our address:

***The cell service as you approach Lake Logan is EXTREMELY LIMITED!! So be sure to download or print off directions before you leave.

Here's a map and directions to assist!



From the East (Asheville—1-40 West)

- Travel on I-40 West to Exit #37 (E Canton).
- Turn left at the bottom of the ramp.
- At red light turn right on Hwy 19/23 South.
- Travel 4.8 miles to 2nd traffic light in downtown Canton.
- Veer right across intersection to remain on 19/23 South.
- Travel only 0.2 mi. (about 5 blocks).
- Turn left on Hwy 110 South (Sorrels St) just before bridge.
- Travel 5.4 mi. to traffic light at Hwy 276.
- Go straight onto Hwy 215 South.
- Travel 2.8 mi. to Lake Logan Road. Turn left.
- Travel 3.6 mi. to Lake Logan Conference Center

FROM THE WEST (KNOXVILLE -I-40 EAST)

- Travel on I-40 East to Exit #31.
- Turn right at bottom of ramp (Hwy 215).
- At the intersection of Hwy 215 & Hwy 19/23, turn left.
- Travel .7 mile and Hwy 215 veers to the right.
- Travel 6 miles on Hwy 215 to Hwy 276.
- Turn left in front of Bethel Grocery, go 1 mile.
- Turn right onto Lake Logan Road (just past Bethel Grocery),
- Travel 6, miles on Lake Logan Road to the main entrance of Lake Logan Episcopal Center

FROM THE SOUTH (ATLANTA)

- Travel East on Hwy 23/74 to Exit #98 (W. Waynesville).
- Turn right at bottom of ramp. Travel 1/10 of a mile.
- Turn left onto Hwy Business 23.
- Travel 2.0 miles into Waynesville.
- Turn right onto Hwy 276 South and travel 5.7 miles.
- Turn right onto Lake Logan Road (just past Bethel Grocery).
- Travel 5.8 miles to Lake Logan Episcopal Center.

Drop Off and Pick Up Times and Locations

On the first day of your campers' program, registration will **begin promptly at 3:00 p.m.** and will last until 5:00 p.m. There will be signs that direct you to Check In when you enter Lake Logan/Camp Henry property. If for some reason you plan or anticipate arriving at camp later than 5:00 p.m., please contact the Camp Henry office to arrange for one of our staff members to meet you. Please also respect the time and space that our staff need to prepare for your arrival, and do not plan on showing up too early. You may help your camper take their luggage to their cabin after they are registered.

On the last day of your campers' program, **pick up will be at 10:00 a.m.** and will take place at the craft pavilion. Please follow signs to the pick up area when you enter Lake Logan/Camp Henry property. Your camper's luggage will be near the pick up area and please feel free to load it into your car. **HOWEVER** it is **VERY IMPORTANT** that you **DO NOT** leave without signing your camper out first. Please remember to take home any medications you dropped off with our Camp Nurse and to check the lost and found before you go.

In the event that a Drop off or Pick up time and/or location has changed Camp Henry will notify you by email and phone.



Packing Checklist – Camp Session (1 Week)

- Soap/body wash
- Deodorant
- Other personal/hygienic items
- Medications (optional/as needed, Camp
Henry provides basic first aid, but if
your child takes regular medication/
has emergency medications, please
drop those off with the nurse at check
-in!)
